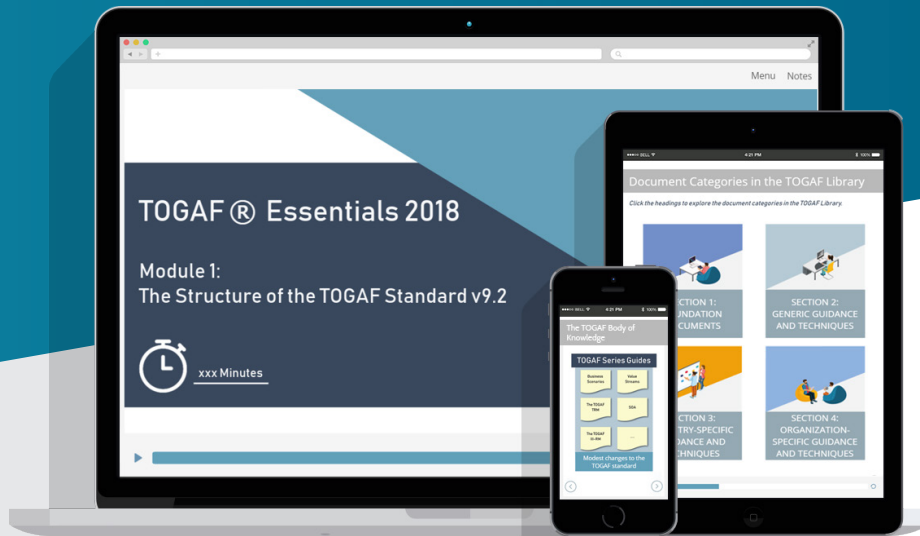

WHAT'S NEW IN TOGAF 9.2?

There are several important changes from 9.1 to 9.2 such as:

- Changes to the structure of the standard and the importance of the TOGAF Library
- Additions to the Business Architecture domain in the TOGAF Standard
- Changes introduced in ISO/IEC/IEEE 42010:2011 and the consequent changes
- Changes to the TOGAF Content Framework and Metamodel
- Changes to security considerations addressed during ADM application
- Changes to the terms and definitions in the TOGAF Standard, Version 9.2

IS THERE AN EXAM?

On completing the course, students will need to submit their details to their Accredited Training Provider who will then submit the details to The Open Group who will then send an email invitation to take the assessment.

- The assessment is taken online
- Invitations are issued by The Open Group

- The assessment invitations are valid for at least 60 days
- Comprises 20 multiple-choice questions
- 30 minute's time limit
- 75% pass mark
- If you fail, you have 2 retakes accessible via the same URL

To submit candidate details to Open Group, the Accredited Training Provider will need to have the candidate ID, first name, last name and email address. The Accredited Training Provider can provide details on how to find a candidate ID.

If you pass, you will receive an invitation to accept your TOGAF Essentials 2018 Credential!

THE OPEN GROUP CREDENTIALS
